LETTER OF CONCERN

**RE: 05-11 Board Review
Physician Self Report on 2005 Renewal pursuant to A.R.S. §32-3208**

Dear Dr. Radoff:

At a meeting held March 8, 2005, the Board reviewed information concerning the above referenced matter. Following discussion the Board voted to issue you a non-disciplinary *Letter of Concern*. A *Letter of Concern* is defined at A.R.S. §32-2901(13) as an advisory letter to notify a physician that, while there is insufficient evidence to support disciplinary action, the board believes the physician should modify or eliminate certain practices.

The referenced 2005 renewal form was received by the Board on January 11, 2005. During review of the information provided on the renewal form Board personnel noted your report of a traffic citation received for a DUI on February 8, 2004 that had occurred in Scottsdale, Arizona. The Board requested further information and on February 24, 2005 you submitted documentation concerning your conviction and guilty plea for violating A.R.S. §28-1381.A1, First Offense DUI, a Class 1 misdemeanor. The documentation indicates you complied with court ordered requirements including fines, 16 hours of Substance Abuse Education at the Center for Recovering Families in Scottsdale, Arizona and attendance at a MADD Victim Impact Panel held September 20, 2004 at Mesa Community College.

Following a review of the available information and in light of your self report of the violation at the next available license renewal opportunity (ie. 2005 renewal application) the Board voted to issue a *Letter of Concern*. Their decision was predicated on a concern that you failed to report your arrest on the misdemeanor charges within ten days from the initial date the charges were filed, as required by A.R.S. §32-3208. While there was insufficient evidence to conclude an intentional violation of A.R.S. §32-3208, the Board expressed concern regarding the lack of timely reporting.

With the issuance of this letter, a copy of which will be retained in your license file, this matter will be administratively closed. Please contact me if you have questions.
