

CONSENT TO ENTRY OF ORDER

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2 1. Dr. Wright has read and understands this Order for Practice Limitation and Consent to
3 the Same and the stipulated Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order (“Order”). Dr. Wright
4 acknowledges she has the right to consult with legal counsel regarding this matter.

5 2. Dr. Wright acknowledges and agrees that this Order is entered into freely and
6 voluntarily and that no promise was made or coercion used to induce such entry.

7 3. By consenting to this Order, Dr. Wright voluntarily relinquishes any rights to a hearing or
8 judicial review in state or federal court on the matters alleged, or to challenge this Order in its entirety
9 as issued, and waives any other cause of action related thereto or arising from said Order.

10 4. The Order is not effective until approved and signed by the Executive Director on behalf
11 of the Board.

12 5. All admissions made by Dr. Wright are solely for final disposition of this matter and any
13 subsequent related administrative proceedings or civil litigation involving the Board and Dr. Wright.
14 Therefore, said admissions by Dr. Wright are not intended or made for any other use, such as in the
15 context of another state or federal government regulatory agency proceeding, civil or criminal court
16 proceeding, in the State of Arizona or any other state or federal court.

17 6. Upon signing this agreement, and returning this document (or a copy thereof) to the
18 Board’s Executive Director, Dr. Wright may not revoke the consent to the entry of the Order. Dr. Wright
19 may not make any modifications to the Document. Any modifications to this original document are
20 ineffective and void unless mutually approved by the parties.

21 7. This Order is a public record that will be publicly disseminated as a formal *non-*
22 *disciplinary* action of the Board.

1 8. If any part of the Order is later declared void or otherwise unenforceable, the remainder
2 of the Order in its entirety shall remain in force and effect.

3 9. Any violation of this Order constitutes unprofessional conduct and may result in
4 disciplinary action. A.R.S. §32-2933(32) ("violating a formal board order, terms of probation or a
5 stipulation issued or entered into by the board or its designee under this chapter") and A.R.S. § 32-2934.
